We grow a wide variety of certified organic crops which are sold through our 4 season CSA and also through wholesale. We grow and sell year round, with winter production in 8 unheated high tunnels. We tend to lean towards tractor based production with the exception of our tunnels. We grow a lot of food!

About the job:

We are looking to add one person to our crew for our busiest field season months, with the potential of year round employment in the future. All of our crew members participate in greenhouse work, planting, cultivation, harvesting and packing. Some crew members also have particular tasks which usually involve a tractor in some capacity. We are pretty flexible and willing to set people up on particular aspects of the farm. Preference is given to people with past farm experience and tractor operation.
